

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will widen State Route (SR) 36 between Sunset Lane and Stansbury Park, improve and resurface intersections on northbound SR-36 and add an auxiliary lane on eastbound I-80 from SR-36 to the SR-201 exit. This project is being done to improve mobility and reduce congestion for drivers. Construction will be done in phases and continue through 2025.

- Southbound SR-36 will be widened to three lanes between Sunset Lane and Stansbury Parkway.

Construction 2025
NB SR-36
EB I-80

- Northbound SR-36 will be widened to three lanes between Stansbury Parkway and the eastbound I-80 on-ramp.
- Intersections will be improved.
- An auxiliary lane will be added to eastbound I-80 from SR-36 to the SR-201 exit.

State Route 201

I-215 to Bangerter Highway

Project Overview: The Bridge Deck Rehabilitation Project is located on State Route 201 at 3200 West. Crews will demolish the two bridge decks on SR-201 and replace them with new, smoother driving surfaces. Drivers should expect delays of more than 30 minutes on SR-201 during peak travel times. 3200 W. is scheduled to be closed to traffic under the SR-201 bridge during construction. Traffic on SR-201 will be detoured down and up the ramps in a free-flow condition with right-in/right-out access at 3200 W. Construction is expected to start summer 2024 and take approximately six months to complete.




SR-201 over 3200 W. Bridge Rehabilitation

State Route 201

I-215 to Bangerter Highway

3200 W. traffic under the SR-201 bridge is scheduled to be closed during construction. Detours will be Bangerter Highway and Redwood Rd.

Northbound Detour:


For traffic heading eastbound and intending to travel northbound on 3200 W., please be advised of the following detour route: Traffic will be detoured to Redwood Rd., where traffic can turnaround and proceed west on SR-201 and turn right to get off at 3200 W.



3200 W. Northbound Detour

Southbound Detour:

For traffic heading westbound and intending to travel southbound on 3200 W., please be advised of the following detour route: Traffic will be detoured to Bangerter Highway, where traffic can turnaround and proceed east on SR-201 and turn right to get off at 3200 W.



3200 W. Southbound Detour
